Some fun & exciting highlights in the Sunshine Classes are; Daisy the Reading Dog visits the pupils once a week and they read stories with Daisy.

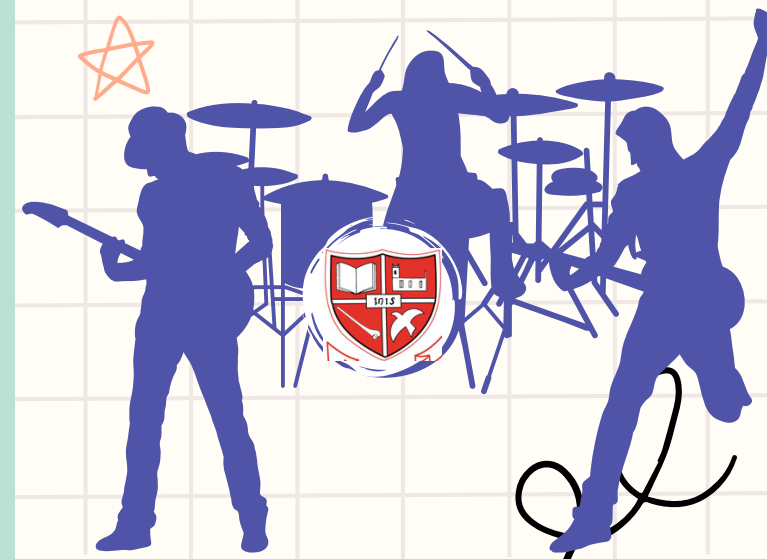
Pupils have a weekly gymnastics class at the Ennis Gymnastics Centre, nature walks & visits to the school garden.
